Graduation 2018

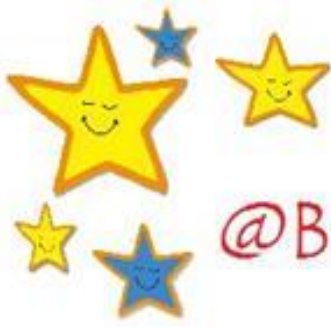
